NOTE
<p>Argan oil has been used in Morocco as food and applied to the skin for centuries; there are currently no known acute or chronic toxicity levels. In 2001, AFSSA (France) assessed the substantial equivalence of argan oil (<i>Argania spinosa</i> L.) with other food oils. On the basis of the evidence presented in the record, the substantial equivalence of argan oil with existing oils has been demonstrated for its composition, nutritional values, metabolism, the use for which it is intended and its content of undesirable substances. <i>Argania spinosa</i> kernel oil is included in the CIR Expert Panel's review of plant-derived fatty acids oils. Based on a history of safe use in food and cosmetics, the composition of the oils and data indicating these ingredients were not dermal irritants or sensitizers, the CIR Expert Panel concluded that plantderived fatty acid oils, including <i>Argania spinosa</i> kernel oil, are safe as used in cosmetic products.
